15.75	Stream, 2 lks. wide, course N.
36.25	A point about 650 ft. below top of mountain and set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N face, from which A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.70*E., 31 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.41*E., 21 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
44.90	Stream, 5 lks. wide, course NW. A point about 200 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
55.25	Stream, 10 lks. wide, course NW., and ascend to
76.25	A point about 350 ft. above last stream. The cor. to secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35. Land mountainous, 76.25 chs. Heavily timbered with fir, cedar, and laurel, with a dense undergrowth of hazel and briars, 76.25 chs.

10.35	Stream, 3 lks. wide, course N.80*W., a point about 250 ft. below sec. cor. and ascend.
37.00	Top of a ridge, course W., about 650 ft. high and descend.
39.40	Stream, 1 lk. wide, course W.; ascend.
40.00	Set a post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W face, from which A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.24*E., 60 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T; A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.60*W., 33 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
74.00	Top of a spur, on W slope, about 250 ft. high and descend.
80.00	A point about 150 ft. below top of spur. Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27, marked T 24 S S 23 on NE., R 7 W S 26 on SE., S 27 on SW., and S 22 on NW., faces
