10.30	Lost Creek, 30 lks. wide, course NW. A point about 300 ft. below cor. and ascend.
36.24	A point about 650 ft. above Lost Creek and set a post, 3 ins. sq., 3 ft. long, 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N face, from which <p style="margin-left: 40px;">A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.45*E., 63 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S P T.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">A Chinquapin, 10 ins. diam., bears N.23*W., 45 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S P T.</p>
76.24	A point about 1050 ft. above Lost Creek.
