	Ascend over W. slope.
19.70	Intersect S. bdy. of the Tp., 3.14 chs. E. of cor. to secs. 3 and 4, at which point, I set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to secs. 33 and 34, marked C C T 24 SR 7 W on N., S 34 on E., and S 33 on W., with 3 notches on E and W sides, from which <div style="margin-left: 40px;">A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.61*E., 64 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 7 WS 34 B T.</div> <div style="margin-left: 40px;">A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.20*W., 37 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 7 W S 33 B T.</div> <div style="margin-left: 40px;">A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.1*30'W., 7 lks. dist. marked T 24 S R 7 W C C S 33 and 34 B T.</div> <p>Land mountainous, 19.70 chs. Soil 3rd and 4th rate. Heavily timbered with fir, cedar and alder, with a dense undergrowth of hazel, arrowwood and briars, 19.70 chs.</p>

6.00	Top of a ridge, course N.10*E.
12.50	Top of same ridge, course N.30*W., about 150 ft. above cor. and descend.
20.70	A stream, 2 lks. wide, course SE. A point about 150 ft. below top of ridge, and ascend.
26.00	Top of a spur, of main ridge, course S.50*E.
39.10	Wagon Road, from Elkton to Bohannan's Ranch, course S.60*W. on top of ridge, about 100 ft. high and descend gradually.
46.60	Same road, course SE.
