

Subdivisions of T 24 S. R 7 W. W.M.

CHAINS

I begin at the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 32 and 33, which is a post, 3 ins. sq., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face from which
 A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.25*E., 45 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
 A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.20*W., 67 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

Thence I run

S.0*3'E., on a true line bet. secs. 32 and 33.

Ve. 20*30'E.

Descend.

- 1.00 A stream, 1 lk. wide, course NW., and ascend.
- 10.00 Top of a ridge, course N.80*W., about 300 ft. high and descend.
- 17.75 Stream, 2 lks. wide, course SW. A point about 100 ft. below top of ridge,
- 25.00 Stream, 5 lks. wide, course N.80*W.
- 40.14 Intersect south Pdy. of the Tp., 79 lks. E of cor. to secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, at which point I set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to secs. 32 and 33, marked C C T 24 S R 7 W on N., S 33 on E., and S 32 on W., with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W faces, from which
 A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.86*E., 19 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 7 W S 33 B T.
 A Fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N.35 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 25 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 7 W C C S 32 and 33 E T.

Land 40.14 chs., mountainous.

Soil 3rd and 4th rate.

Heavily timbered with fir, 40.14 chs.

Dense undergrowth of vinemaple, arrowwood, and briars, 40.14 chs.

I begin at the cor. to secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20 which is a post, 4 ins. sq., marked T 24 S S17 on NE., R 7 W S 20
