	Thence I run S.0*17'W., on a true line bet. secs. 7 and 8. Va. 20*20'E.
13.85	Stream, 1 lk. wide, course NW., and ascend to
25.00	Top of mountain, course N.20*E., and S.20*W., with trail on top from Hutchinsons' to Howards', course N.20*E. and descend.
41.35	A Fir, 16 ins. diam., which I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face, from which A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.75*W., 47 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.74 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 45 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
51.95	Stream, 1 lk. wide, course NE. A point about 450 ft. below top of mountain, and ascend to

81.35	The cor. to secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18. Land mountainous, and rolling, 81.35 chs. Soil 2nd and 3rd rate. Heavily timbered with fir and laurel, with a dense under- growth of hazel, arrowwood, and briars, 81.35 chs.

5.00	Stream, 4 lks. wide, course N.20*E. A point about 150 ft. below cor.
18.80	Stream, 2 lks. wide, course N.80*E.
33.50	Top of spur on N. slope, Va. 20*35'E.
40.00	Set a sandstone, 18x10x8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.19*E., 68 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Cross, cut in bed rock, bears S.53*30'W., 118 lks. dist.
