on the S. and 1 notch on the N. edges, from which

A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.17\*E., 64 lks. dist.,

marked T 24 S R 7 W S 6 B T.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.8\*E., 107 lks. dist.,

marked T 24 SR 7 W S 7 B T.

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.16\*W., 59 lks. dist.,

marked T 24 S R 8 W S 12 ET.

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.39\*W., 78 lks. dist.,

marked T 24 S R 8 W S 1 B T.

At this point of intersection I set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to secs. 6 and 7, marked C C T 24 S R 7 W on E., S 6 on N., and S 7 on S., with 5 notches on S and 1 notch on N. faces, from which

A Fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.73\*E., 40 lks. dist.,

marked T 24 SR 7 W S 7 E T.

A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.2\*E., 35 lks. dist.,

marked T 24 S R 7 W S 7 B T.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.64\*W., 34 lks. dist.,

marked T 24 S R 7 W C C S 6 and 7 E T.

Lend mountainous, 81.47 chs.

Soil 2nd and 3rd rate.

Heavily timbered with fir, cedar, and laurel, with a

dense undergrowth of hazel, thimbleberry, sallal,

arrowwood, briars, 81.43 chs.
