A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.40\*E., 33 lks.  
dist., marked T 24 S R 8 W S 23 - B T.

A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.42\*W., 27 lks.  
dist., marked T 24 S R 8 W S 22 - B T.

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.15\*W., 35 lks.  
dist., marked T 24 S R 8 W S 15 - B T.

Land, rolling bench. 7.50 chs.

Land, mountainous. 72.50 chs.

Soil, sandy and rocky, 3rd and 4th rate.

Heavily timbered with Fir and Hemlock. 80 chs.
