61.00 A Spring branch, 1 lk. wide., flows SE., about 300 ft. below top of ridge.

79.56 The cor. to Secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28.

Land, mountainous. 79.56 chs.

Soil, sandy and rocky, 3rd and 4th rate.

Heavily timbered with Fir, and Hemlock. 79.56 chs.

Dense undergrowth of vinemaple, laurel and hazel.
