40.00	Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.20	Intersect N. and S. line, 35 lks. South of the cor. to Secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23 Thence I run N.89°50'W., on a true line bet. Secs. 15 and 22. Va. 20°E.
	Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth about 30 ft. to
1.50	Top of bench, course SE. Thence along bench, sloping to W.
14.00	Leave bench, course SE. Begin to descend into canyon.
38.00	A Creek, 15 lks. wide, flows SE., about 400 ft. below top of bench. Ascend.
