Descend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth about 250 ft. to

17.50 A Brook, 4 lks. wide, flows SE.

Ascend about 200 ft. to

32.00 Top of spur, course E.

Descend.

41.18 Set a post $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W face, from which

A Hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S.43*E., 11 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears N.55*W., 6 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B T.

46.25 A Creek, 10 lks. wide, flows SW. about 150 ft. below top of spur.

Ascend about 50 ft. to

52.50 Top of spur, course W.

Descend about 75 ft. to

63.50 A Creek, 12 lks. wide, flows SE.

Ascend about 50 ft. to

69.00 Top of spur, course E.

Descend about 75 ft. to

81.18 The cor. to secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

Land, mountainous. 81.18 chs.

Soil, sandy and rocky, 3rd and 4th rate.

Heavily timbered with Fir and Hemlock. 81.18 chs.

Dense undergrowth of salal, small hemlock, laurel and rhododendron. 81.18 chs.
