80.00 Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to Secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29, marked T 24 S S 21 on NE., R 8 W S 28 on SE., S 29 on SW., and S 20 on NW faces, with 2 notches on South and 4 notches on East edges, from which

A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.40°E., 84 lks.
