55.00 Top of spur, course NE.

Descend about 50 ft. to

60.00 Bottom of ravine, course SE.

Ascend about 100 ft. to

68.00 Top of divide, course SE.

Descend about 150 ft. to

75.50 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, flows SE.

Ascend about 75 ft. to

80.00 Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the
ground for cor. to Secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, marked
T 24 S S 4 on NE., R 8 W S 9 on SE., S 8 on SW.,
and S 5 on NW. faces, with 5 notches on South and
4 notches on East edges, from which
