CHAINS

Dense undergrowth of vinemaple, hazel, salal and hemlock. 61.70 chs.

N.0*4'W., bet. Secs. 29 and 30.

Va. 20*E.

Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth about 100 ft. to

27.50 Top of divide, course NW.

Descend about 50 ft. to

40.00 On East side of divide.

Set a post $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. face, from which

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.27*E.69 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.57*W., 31 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

41.20 Trail on top of divide, bet. the Umpqua River and Lake Creek, course SE and NW., about 600 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

Descend about 200 ft. to

78.00 Bottom of ravine, course NW.

Ascend about 20 ft. to

80.00 Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to Secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, marked T 24 S S 20 on NE., R 8 W S 29 on SE., S 30 on SW., and S 19 on NW faces, with 2 notches on South and 5 notches on East edges, from which

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.27*E., 69 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 8 W S 20 - B T.

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.13*E., 74 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 8 W S 29 - B T.

A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.28*W., 25 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 8 W S 30 - B T.
