CHAINS

N.89°53'W., on a random line bet. Secs. 6 and 7.

Va. 20°E.

40.00 Set temporary $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.

60.50 Intersect the West boundary of the Tp., 5 lks. North
of the cor. to Secs. 6 and 7, established by myself.

Thence I run

S.89°50'E., on a true line bet. Secs. 6 and 7.

Va. 20°E.

Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth
about 300 ft. to

20.50 Top of ridge, course SW.

Set a post $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the
ground for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. on N. face,
from which

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.12°W., 46 lks.
dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam, bears N.30°E., 41 lks.
dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.

22.00 Bottom of ravine, course SW. about 80 ft. below $\frac{1}{2}$ sec.
cor.

Ascend about 80 ft. to

24.00 Top of spur, course SW.

Descend.

34.50 Rocky bluff, course N. & S.

36.00 Foot of bluff, about 70 ft. below top of spur.

Descend about 600 ft. to

44.00 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, flows SW.

Ascend about 150 ft. to

55.25 Top of spur, course SE.

Descend about 100 ft. to

60.50 The cor. to Secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.

Land, mountainous. 60.50 chs.

Soil, sandy and rocky, 3rd and 4th rate.
