	Land, nearly level. 1st rate.
	Timber, principally fir; maple and ash along creek.
	Underbrush, same. Sept. 17, 1878.
	North, on line between Secs. 23 & 24. Va. 18*E.
15.50	Lake creek, course N., 50 lks. wide.
25.00	Leave lake creek, course NW.
28.50	Lake creek, Course West.
40.00	Set Hemlock post 40 ins. long, 5 ins. dia., 18 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner between Secs. 23 & 24, from which a, Hemlock, 10 ins. dia., bears S.80 *E., 10 lks. dist. Fir, 10 ins. dia., bears S.72* W., 17 lks. dist.
55.00	Enter dry ash swale, course N. & South.
65.00	Open glade. Grass 4 feet high.
70.00	Leave same and swale; enter fir timber.
76.50	Creek, 40 lks. wide, course SW.
80.00	Set a fir post 40 ins. long, 5 ins. dia., on east bank of creek for the corner to Sec. 13, 14, 23 & 24, from which, Fir, 30 ins. dia., bears N.35*E., 26 lks. dist. Fir, 36 ins. dia., bears S.65*E., 32 lks. dist. Fir, 50 ins. dia., bears S.66*W., 112 lks. dist. (across creek) Fir, 50 ins. dia., N.89*W., 110 lks. dist.

	Timber, fir, maple and ash.
	Underbrush, same, and crabapple. Considerable down timber & crabapple thickets difficult to open line.
