

Subdivisions of T. 24 south, R. 9 W.

CHAINS

At the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

Thence I run

N.0°1'W., between secs. 27 and 28.

Over mountainous land through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

4.50 A rocky gulch; course S.W.

Begin steep ascent.

8.00 Top of steep ascent, 200 ft. above sec. cor.

Ascend gradually.

19.50 Top of ascent, 420 ft. above sec. cor. and descend 200 ft.

25.75 A branch, 1 lk. wide; course S.70°W., and ascend.

37.00 Top of ascent, 620 ft. above section corner.

40.00 Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28 on W., and 27 on E. face; from which

A fir, 24 ins. dia., bears S.49°E., 16 lks. dis. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 B T.

A fir, 16 ins. dia., bears N.71°W., 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dis. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28 B T.

77.50 A spur, sloping N.20°W.

80.00 Set a cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 14 ins. in the ground on bedrock, in mound of stone, for cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, marked.
