

Subdivision of T. 24 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

I destroy all marks on post and B TS., referring to secs. 10 and 15 and at the point of intersection of my random line with the W. line of sec. 11,

Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 5 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for C.C. of secs. 10 and 15, marked.

C C T 24 S R 9 W on W.,

S 10 on N., and

S 15 on S. face, with 4 grooves on S. face; from which

A fir, 40 ins. dia., bears S.31*W., 38 lks. dis. mkd. T 24 S R 9 W S 15 B T.

A fir, 40 ins. dia., bears N.62½*W., 81 lks. dis. mkd. T 24 S R 9 W S 10 B T.

Thence I run

West, on a true line bet. secs. 10 and 15,

Over gradual ascent through heavy timber and dense under growth.

9.37 Foot of steep ascent.

24.37 Top of steep ascent, 350 ft. above the C. C.

Thence along mountainside facing S.

28.50 A gulch, 150 ft. deep; course S W.

31.00 A gulch; course S.

34.00 Top of spur, 100 ft. above gulch, slopes S.

38.95 Bottom of gulch, 115 ft. below top of spur; course S.

39.37 Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. marked ¼ S 10 on N., and 15 on S face; from which

A fir, 20 ins. dia., bears N. 50 *E., 26½ lks. dis. mkd. ¼ S 10 B T.

A fir, 40 ins. dia., bears S.16*E., 19 lks. dis. mkd. ¼ S 15 B T.

Continue descent down a steep hillside, facing S.

49.65 A stream, 4 lks. wide, 300 ft. below point of descent; course S.E.

Ascend on hillside, sloping N.
