A fir, 36 ins. dia., bears S.38*E., 10 lks. dist., mkd T 24 S R 9 W S 16 B T. A fir, 18 ins. dia., bears S.84*W., 35 lks. dist., mkd T 24 S R 9 W S 17 B T. A fir, 18 ins. dia., bears N.10*W., 44 lks. dist., mkd T 24 S R 9 W S 8 B T.
