mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 31 B T.

47.70 A stream 5 lks. wide, 600 ft. below summit of divide;  
course W. and ascend.

74.00 Summit of ridge, sloping S W., 330 ft. above stream.

80.00 Set a yew post, 3-ft. long, 5 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the  
ground, for cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, marked
