51.74	Point of hill, 200 ft. above branch and descend.
63.24	A stream, 8 lks. wide, 270 ft. below point of hill; course S.20*W.
75.24	The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32. Land, mountainous. Soil; 3rd rate. Timber, fir, hemlock and chinquapin. Undergrowth, huckleberry, vine maple, rhododendron, salal and Oregon grape. Land, mountainous, heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth, 75.24 chs. <p style="text-align: right;">September 9, 1905</p>

A fir, 12 ins. dia., bears N.74 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 84 lks. dis. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 30 B T.
57.90	Branch, 1 lk. wide; course SE.
76.00	Blazed trail on main divide bet. Coos Creek and Lake creek, 330 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; course NW. and SE.
80.00	Set a hemlock post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, marked.
