CHAINS

In secs. 8, 9 and 10 there are some croppings of shale. The soil is sandy and from 2 to 4 ft. deep, except along lake creek, where it is much deeper and of a better quality.

There are no roads nor trails which can be travelled with horses, except such as I have constructed.

Lake Creek is a stream with average width of about 75 ft. runs through the North of secs. 7 and 8 and the NE. cor. of sec. 10. Its rapid current will make it valuable for development of power.

There are no settlers in the township.
