1 notch on S sides from which

A Hemlock, 6 ins. diam., bears N.29*E., 26 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 1 W S 30 B T.

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.26*E., 31 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 1 W S 31 B T.

A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.25*W., 65 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 W S 36 B T.

A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.35*30'W., 27 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 W S 25 B T.

Land rolling.

Soil Stony, 2nd rate.

Timber, fir, pine and hemlock.

Undergrowth Rhododendron, vinemaple and spicewood.

Land heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.

North bet. secs. 25 and 30,

Over rolling ground, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Ascend 60 ft. to

5.15 Old Indian and miners trail, much traveled and well cut out, on top of ridge bears E and W and descend.

10.00 Descent becomes very steep.

33.35 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide flows N.10*E.

37.95 Spring branch, 4 lks. wide flows NE.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 18x10x8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W face, from which

A Cedar, 16 in. diam., bears N.71*E., 31 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 30 B T.

A Hemlock, 4 ins. diam., bears N.39*W., 24 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 25 B T.

Ascend 50 ft. to

50.00 Spur slopes NE and descend 100 ft. to

59.20 Spring branch, 4 lks. wide, flows NE and ascend along E slope 150 ft. to
