51.10	Trail on the summit of ridge bears NW and SE about 500 ft. above sec. cor., enter burn, bears NW and SE and descend 200 ft. to
76.80	Dry creek bed, course S and enter timber bearing N and S and ascend 40 ft. to
79.88	The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35. Land mountainous. Soil, clay loam, rocky, 3rd rate. Timber, fir, hemlock and pine. Undergrowth, fir, hemlock, vinemaple, willow and spicewood. Mountainous land, or land covered with heavy timber or dense undergrowth, 79.88 chs.

	N.2'W., bet. secs. 26 and 27. Over mountainous land through heavy timber and dense undergrowth. Ascend 75 ft. to
6.00	Spur, slopes SW and descend 20 ft. to

40.00	Set a fir post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 on W., S 26 on E faces, from which A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.35*W., 8 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 B T. A Hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears N.68*E., 35 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 26 B T.
44.50	Spur slopes NE and continues descent.
