A Dogwood, 6 ins. diam., bears S.56\*W., 13 lks.  
dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 20 B T.

A Hemlock, 4 ins. diam., bears N.31\*E., 11 lks.

A Cedar, 14 ins. diam., bears S.45\*E., 75 lks.  
dist., marked T 25 S R 1 W S 21 B T.
