	Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.
	Along summit of ridge.
0.45	Trail bears NW and SE.
2.50	Trail bears SW and NE.
4.25	Trail bears W.
5.20	Leave trail, bears SW.
7.56	Trail bears NW and SE and descend along S slope of ridge.
21.83	Fir tree, 60 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on E and W sides.
27.50	Ravine, 60 ft. deep, course S and ascend 100 ft. to
36.75	Trail on summit of ridge bears S.80*W and NE., and descend along steep rocky N slope.

64.50	Summit of sharp rocky peak, called Fairview, bare of vegetation on the summit and descend.
68.00	Enter heavy timber and dense undergrowth, bears N and S.
75.00	Ravine, course N., 200 ft. below summit and ascend 100 ft. to
96.00	Spur slopes N and descend 200 ft. to
