13.50 Enter green timber, course N & S.

16.22 A fir, 30 ins. diam.

40.00 Set cedar post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. corner marked ¼ on N face, from which,
A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears S.20°W., 30 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

A cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears N.30°E., 16 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

49.00 A brook, 4 lks. wide, course N.70°E.

51.20 A fir, 22 ins. diam.

60.85 A hemlock, 24 ins. diam.

75.00 A ridge, course N.25°E.

80.00 Set cedar post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for corner to secs. 4, 5, 32 & 33 marked T 25 S S 33 on NE., R 2 W S 4 on SE., T 26 S S 5 on SW., and S 32 on NW faces with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W edges, from which,

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.65°E., 28 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 W S 33 B T.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.10°E., 22 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 2 W S 4 B T.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.20°W., 27 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 2 W S 5 B T.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.55°W., 5 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 W S 32 B T.

Land mountainous. Soil 3rd rate. Densely covered with forest of pine, fir, cedar, hemlock, laurel & dogwood. Thick undergrowth of fir, hazel & sallal.
