A cedar, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 45° E., 7 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

A cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 30° W., 12 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

44.80 A fir, 20 ins. diam.

61.35 A hemlock, 18 ins. diam.

80.00 Set cedar post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for corner to secs. 5, 6, 31 & 32 marked T 25 S S 32 on NE., R 2 W S 5 on SE., T 26 S S 6 on SW. and S 31 on NW faces with 5 notches on E and 1 notch on W edges, from which,

A maple, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 50° E., 66 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 W S 32 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 5° E., 65 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 2 W S 5 B T.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 85° W., 55 lks. dist., marked T 26 S R 2 W S 6 B T.

A cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 50° W., 57 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 W S 31 B T.

Land mountainous. Soil 3rd rate. Densely covered with forest of pine, fir, cedar, hemlock, yew, alder & maple. Thick undergrowth of hazel, vine maple, sallow & manzanita etc.
