A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.21*W., 24 lks. dist.,
marked T 25 S R 3 W S 24 B T.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.38*W., 129 lks. dist.,
marked T 25 S R 3 W S 13 B T.

Land mountainous. Soil 3rd rate. Densely covered with forest of fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, maple, alder, yew, chinquapin, laurel & dogwood. Thick undergrowth of sallal, vine maple, hazel, fir, laurel, manzanita, salmonberry, & thimbleberry etc.

80.00 Set hemlock post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for corner to secs. 7, 12, 13 & 18 marked T 25 S S 7 on NE., R 2 W S 18 on SE., R 3 W S 13 on SW., S 12 on NW faces with 2 notches on N and 4 notches on S edges, from which,

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.15*E., 16 lks. dist.,
marked T 25 S R 2 W S 7 B T.

A chinquapin, 10 ins. diam., bears S.48*E., 75 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 W S 18 B T.
