

## Subdivisional and Exterior Lines of T. 25 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

CHAINS	
	Thence I run, S.89°57'W on a true line between sec. 16 and 21. Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth. Descend.
1.27	A fir, 36 ins. diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on E and W sides.
8.00	Ravine, course NW about 60 ft. below sec. cor. and ascend 40 ft. to
13.75	Spur, slopes NW and descend 100 ft. to
23.14	Brook, 16 lks. wide, flows NW and ascend 60 ft. to
29.50	Spur, slopes N and descend 80 ft. to
35.50	Enter Rock Creek bottom bears N and S.
39.93	Set a washed boulder 20 x 14 x 8 ins., 15 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N face, from which A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.39°E., 29 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 21 B T. A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.46°E., 33 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 B T.
43.25	Touch bend in brook, from the NE to NW.
44.50	Deserted cabin on North edge of small clearing bears South 75 lks. dist.
45.60	Brook, 20 lks. wide, flows SW.
50.10	Trail bears N and S.
51.00	Rock Creek 80 lks. wide, flows S and ascend steep bluff 90 ft. to
58.00	Top of bluff bears N and S and ascend gradually over rolling ground to
79.86	The cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21. Land mountainous, rolling and level. Soil clay loam, 2nd rate. Timber fir, hemlock, cedar and pine. Undergrowth hemlock, vine maple, hazel and fir.
