CHAINS	Mountainous land or land covered with heavy timber or dense undergrowth. 80 chs.
40.00	East on a random line between secs. 20 and 29. Set a temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Intersect N and S lines 15 lks. S of the cor. of secs. 20 21, 28 and 29.
80.26	Thence I run, S.89*54'W on a true line between secs. 20 and 29. Over level bottom land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
20.50	Rock Creek, 95 lks. wide, flows S.30*W.
23.21	Trail, bears NE and SW.
34.00	Wagon road, bears NE and SW about 75 ft. to
