Densely covered with forests of Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Pine, Maple, Alder, Yew, Chinquapin, Laurel and Dogwood. Thick undergrowth of Sallal, Vine-maple, Hazel, Manzanita, Laurel, Fir, Huckleberry and Salmonberry.
