CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

This township is mountainous throughout. Mt. Scott is situated in Section 28 and has an elevation of about 6000 feet. It is watered by small brooks of pure water. The soil along the streams is first rate, on the ridges, it is 3rd rate.

The township is densely covered with a forest of Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, Maple, Alder, Chinquapin, Laurel, Yew and Chittim. There is a thick undergrowth of Sallal, Vinemaple, Hazel, Manzanita, Fir, Salmon, Huckleberry and Thimblebery

The timber found here is of a large size and valueable for lumbering purposes.
