

Retracement of E. Bdy. of T. 25 S., R. 7 W. Sec. 13.

CHAINS

Ascend from cor. 750 ft. to

30.00 Summit of ridge.

40.00 $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. gone. Witness trees still standing but
markings. overgrown.

80.10 Intersect E. and W. line, 20 lks. E. of cor. to secs. 7, 12,
13 and 18, which is a Fir post still standing marked and
witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

This line therefore bears N.9*W., and S9*E.

I find no irregularities in the S. and E. Bdys.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 4th rate, very rocky.

Timber, Fir, Oak, and Madrone, of but little value.

Undergrowth, Hazel, Amm-wood, Pigeon berry, Briars and
Fern.

Mountainous land, or land covered with dense undergrowth
