- A W. Oak, 30 ins. diam., bears N.14°E., 17 lks. dist.
- A W. Oak, 18 ins. diam., bears N.15°W., 47 lks. dist.
- A W. Oak, 24 ins. diam., bears S.75°E., 43 lks. dist.
- A B. Oak, 9 ins. diam., bears S.32°W., 35 lks. dist.

Va 19°30'E.

40.30 $\frac{1}{2}$ post not found, witness trees found. Made and set cedar post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq. from which

- A Laurel, 24 ins. diam., bears S.60°W., 28 lks. dist.
- A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.80°W., 30 lks. dist.

73.85 Rocky ridge, N and S.

80.50 Set new post to cor. 4, 5, 32 and 33 from which

- A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.80°E., 28 lks. dist.
- A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.70°E., 71 lks. dist.
- A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.50°W., 60 lks. dist.
- A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.85°W., 140 lks. dist.
