## Retracement of N. Bdy. of T. 25 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

CHAINS	
13.00	Summit of mountain bears N and S, 75 ft. above cor.
40.28	$\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. a fir post, firmly set in the ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General; thence descend.
42.00	A stream, 4 lks. wide, course N. 800 ft. below summit of mountain, and ascend.
62.00	Summit of ridge, bears N and S 200 ft. above creek. Descend.
72.50	Small branch, . . . . . 600 ft. below ridge.
80.38	The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35. A fir post marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General. Land, mountainous. Soil, 4th rate. Timber, Fir, Cedar and Maple. Undergrowth hazel, arrowwood, thimble berry and briars. Mountainous land, or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.38 chs.
	Oct. 27, 1896
	East, between secs. 2 and 35.  Va 20*10' E  Descend from cor.
8.50	Branch, 10 lks. wide, course N. 200 ft. below cor. Ascend.
40.50	$\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor, a fir post firmly set in the ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
43.00	Leave green timber and enter old burn.
45.50	Summit of ridge bears N and S, 300 ft. above last creek. Descend.
62.50	Creek, 15 chs. wide, course NE, 400 ft. below ridge. Ascend.
68.00	Summit of ridge, 100 ft. above creek, bears N and S. Descend.
72.00	Creek 15 chs. wide, course NE, 180 ft. below ridge. Ascend.
75.00	Summit of ridge 40 ft. above creek, bears nearly N and S. Descend.
77.00	Small branch course NW., 50 ft. below ridge. Ascend.
