marked T 25 S R 7 W S 16 B T.

A Maple, 6 ins. diam., bears S.47°W., 32 lks. dist.
marked T 25 S R 7 W S 17 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.37°W., 8 lks. dist.
marked T 25 S R 7 W S 8 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, Cedar, Maple and Myrtle.

Undergrowth, Laurel, Myrtle, Hazel and arrowwood.

Mountainous land or land covered with dense undergrowth

West, on a true line between secs. 8 and 17.

Still ascend.

20.50 Summit of ridge, 225 ft. above cor. bears N and S.
marked a fir, 14 ins. diam. on line with 2 notches
on E and W sides.

26.50 A fir, 84 ins. diam. on line, a mark with 2 notches
on E and W sides.

40.00 Set a fir post 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq, 24 ins. in the
ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N face, from which
A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.36°E., 50 lks. dist.
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.59°W., 50 lks. dist.
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

43.00 Branch 5 lks. wide, course N. 90 ft. below ridge. Ascend.

52.25 Summit of ridge, 300 ft. above branch, thence along N
side of mountain over uneven ground.

58.00 A fir, 24 ins diam. on line, a mark with 2 notches on
E and W sides.

78.00 Summit of ridge bears N and S.
