 secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, hereinbefore described.

Thence I run

S0*9'W. on a true line between secs. 1 and 2.

Ascend gradually from cor.

7.50 Summit of ridge, 50 ft. above cor. bears N.W and S.E.
 and descend rocky bluff.

9.00 Branch, 10 lks. wide, course NW, 200 ft. below cor.
 ascend perpendicular rock, 60 ft. high.

25.00 Summit of rocky bluff.

42.25 Set a fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the
 ground.

66.50 Dry gulch, course NW. 800 ft. above cor.

73.00 A fir, 36 ins. diam. on line, 1 mark with 2 notches
 on N and S sides.

82.25 The cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 4th rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar, partly deadened by fire.

Undergrowth Fir, Hemlock, Arrowwood, Fern and Briars.

Mountain land, or land covered with dense undergrowth
