CHAINS 40.10	Ravine, 150 ft. deep, course S.60*E. Ascend steep S. slope
56.25	Divide bet. Bottom Creek and Coos River, 500 ft. above Arrow Creek, bears N.80*E. and S.80*W. Descend N. slope into Bottom Creek basin
68.75	Ravine 200 ft. deep, course N.50*W. Ascend gradually over small ridges and ravines on W. slope of ridge.
80.00	Set a sandstone 24x15x10 ins., 18 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25,30,31 & 36, marked with 5 notches on the N. and 1 notch on the S. edges from which A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.35*E. 79 lks. dist. marked T 25S R 8 W S 30 B T A fir, 44 ins. diam., bears S.85*E. 25 lks. dist. marked T 25 S R 8 W S 31 B T A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears S.37 $\frac{1}{4}$ *W. 49 lks. dist. marked T 25 S R 9 W S 36 B T A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.32 $\frac{3}{4}$ *W. 50 lks. dist. marked T 25 S R 9 W S 25 B T Land mountainous Soil stony and gravelly 2nd & 3rd rate Timber heavy fir, hemlock & spruce Undergrowth huckleberry, small firs & laurel Mountainous and heavily timbered land 80.00 chs.
	North, bet. secs. 25 & 30 Descend along W. slope of ridge through heavy timber and undergrowth
1.50	Ravine 25 ft. deep, course N.60*W. Ascend over rolling flat
7.50	Ridge point, 50 ft. above ravine bears N.60*W. and S.60*E. From this point, Albert Pellsman's cabin bears S.61*E. about 3.00 chs. dist. Descend steep N. slope into Bottom Creek
