CHAINS	line, course N.30*E.
	Over bottom
7.50	Ascend steep E. slope of hill and enter undergrowth bears E. and W.
8.75	A fir, 64 ins. diam., on line I mark with 2 notches on N. and S. sides
14.50	More gradual ascent
20.00	Top of hill bears NE. and SW. 200 ft. high Over level ground on top of hill
23.00	Descend into canyon
28.75	Foot of descent bears E. and W. 200 ft. below top of hill Over bottom
29.80	Branch of Lake Creek 10 lks. wide course East Ascend steep S. slope
37.50	Top of ridge, 250 ft. above creek bears N.60*E. and S.60*W. Descend over broken ground sloping toward the North
40.00	Set hemlock post 3 ft. long 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 on the W. and S 6 on the E. faces from which A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.87 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E. 32 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears S.85*W. 29 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
41.50	More gradual descent
44.20	Spring branch 2 lks. wide course N.60*E. Enter old burn bears E. and W. live timber still standing
50.00	Descend steep bank into canyon
52.25	Spring branch 5 lks. wide in canyon 300 ft. deep course N.80*E. Ascend
64.00	Spring branch 2 lks. wide course S.60*E.
66.00	Top of ascent 200 ft. above foot of canyon bears E. and W.
