3.16	The cor. of secs. 16 and 21 Thence N.0*02'W. bet. secs. 16 and 17 Ascend steep ridge, in heavy timber and underbrush
6.00	Top of spur, course SW. 150 ft. above sec. cor. Descend through timber and brush
19.00	Bottom of canon course SW. Ascend
31.00	Clark Haines house, bears E. 23 chs. dist.
31.74	Bottom of rimrock, 80 ft. high
31.99	Top of rimrock
32.50	Top of main ridge; also Ranger Trail, course E. and W. 1200 ft. above canon
40.00	Set a fir post, 3 ft. long 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 17 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 17 on W. face from which A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears West, 40 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 17 B T A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears N.45*W. 52 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 17 B T
43.16	Set cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 16 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 on E. face; from which A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears S.22*30'E. 36 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 B T A hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears N.3*E. 75 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 B T
43.20	Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course NE.
46.20	Creek 3 lks. wide, course NW. Ascend through heavy timber and underbrush
50.50	Chandlers Horse trail, bears NW. and SE.
