CHAINS

- 67.80 Chandlers trail, bears NE. and SW.
- 70.80 Top of main divide, bears NW. and SE., 2000 ft. above sea level.
- Descend in dense timber and rhododendron.
- 77.15 Edge of Chandlers clearing, bears E. and W.
- 79.15 Chandlers barn, bears N.70\*W. 130 lks. dist.; house, bears N.30\*W. 5 chs. dist.
- 80.00 Set a cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 8 and 17 marked T 25 S S 17 on SW., R 8 W S 8 on NW. faces; with 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on N. edges; from which
- A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.39\*30'W. 46 lks. dist.  
marked T 25 S R 8 W S 17 B T
- A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.51\*W. 58 lks. dist.  
marked T 25 S R 8 W S 8 B T
- 81.15 Edge of bluff
- Descend
- 83.16 Set fir post, 3 ft. long 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 9 and 16 marked T 25 S S 9 on NE., R 8 W S 16 on SE., with 4 notches on S. and 4 notches on E. faces; from which
- A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.21\*E. 77 lks. dist.  
marked T 25 S R 8 W S 9 B T
- A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.89\*E. 34 lks. dist.  
marked T 25 S R 8 W S 16 B T
- Land, mountainous
- Soil, 2nd and 3rd rate
- Timber, heavy fir, hemlock and cedar
- Dense undergrowth of small rhododendrons and small fir.
- Mountainous land, covered with heavy timber and dense undergrowth, and exceptionally difficult to survey
- 83.16 chs.
