

Subdivisions of T. 25 S., R. 9 W., W. M.

CHAINS	
	N. and S. sides.
40.00	Set a sandstone, 24x12x4 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face; from which, A hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears N.61*E., 20 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 26 B T. A cedar, 20 ins. diam., bears S.54-3/4*W., 37 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S.27 B T.
40.75	N. Fork of Bottom Creek, swift current, sandy bottom, course S.30*E. Thence up creek.
41.75	Leave creek and pass over bottom land.
48.50	N. Fork of Bottom Creek, course S.20*W. Thence up creek.
51.75	Leave creek and pass over bottom land.
52.70	Spring branch, 5 lks. wide, course N.70*E.
54.00	Leave bottom, bears NE. and SW. and ascend along E. slope of mountain.
71.00	More gradual ascent.
75.50	Over gently rolling land.
80.00	Marked a hemlock, 12 ins. diam., for cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27 marked T 25 S S 23 on the NE. R 9 W S 26 on SE. S 27 on SW and S 22 on the NW faces; with 2 notches on the S. and E. edges; from which, A hemlock, 36 ins. diam., bears N.35 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 56 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 9 W S 23 B T. A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears S.23*E., 39 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 9 W S 26 B T. A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears S 29*W., 40 lks. dist. marked T 25 S R 9 W S 27 B T. A hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears N.58 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 58 lks. dist. marked T 25 S R 9 W S 22 B T. Land, level and mountainous. Soil, rich loam and sandy, 1st. and 2nd. rate. Timber, fir, hemlock, maple and alder.
