Subdivisions of T. 25 S., R. 9 W. W. M.,

CHAINS	
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
79.90	Intersect N. and S. line, 7 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12. Thence I run W. on a true line bet. secs. 2 and 11. Descend gradually along S. slope of mountain
7.50	Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, in ravine, 100 ft. deep, course S. Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, bears N. and S.
12.00	Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, in ravine 50 ft. deep, course South.
17.50	Main divide bet. Fall Creek, and Bottom Creek, 1500 ft. above Bottom Creek, bears N.10*E. and S.10*W. Descend along N. slope.
19.75	More gradual descent.
28.00	Ravine 75 ft. deep, course N. Ascend.
35.00	Ridge point, 100 ft. high, bears N. and S. Descend gradually.
39.95	Marked a hemlock, 10 ins. diam., for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 2 on the N. and S. 11 on the S. faces; from which, A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.30*E., 9 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.50*E., 27 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
43.00	Steeper descent into Branch of Fall Creek.
48.50	Branch of Fall Creek, 10 lks. wide, rearing torrent, in canyon, 200 ft. deep, course SW. Ascend over ridge.
50.25	Top of ridge, 200 ft. high, bears NE. and SW. Descend.
79.20	Branch of Fall Creek, 8 lks. wide, swift current, in ravine 10 ft. deep, course S.60*W. Ascend S. slope of mountain.
