CHAINS	
	Over bottom lands.
61.90	Spring branch, 3 lks. wide, course S.10*W.
64.00	Same spring branch course S.10*E.
65.00	Leave Bottom, bears NE. and SW. and ascend S. slope of mountain.
80.00	Set a fir post, 6 ins. sq., 3 ft. long, 24 ins in the ground for cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, marked T 25 S S 27 on NE, R 9 W S 34 on SE, S 33 on SW and S 28 on the NW faces, with 1 notch on S. and 3 notches on the E. edges; from which, A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 75½*E., 54 lks. dist. marked T 25 S R 9 W S 27 B T. A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears S.50*E., 17 lks. dist. marked T 25 S R 9 W S 34 B T. A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.50½*W., 25 lks. dist. marked T 25 S R 9 W S 33 B T. A fir, 42 ins. diam., bears N.40-3/4*W., 28 lks. dist. marked T 25 S R 9 W S 28 B T.
	Land level and mountainous.
	Soil, sandy loam and gravelly; 1st. and 3rd. rate.
	Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple and myrtle.
	Undergrowth, laurel, huckleberry and vine maple.
	Mountainous and heavily timbered lands. 80.00 chs.
	East, on a random line bet. secs. 27 and 34.
40.00	Set temp. ¼ sec. cor.
80.14	Intersect N. and S. line 9 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35. Thence I run, S.89*56'W. on a true line bet. secs. 27 and 34. Descend into Bottom Creek, over broken ground, on N. slope of mountain, heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
12.25	Spring branch, 3 lks. wide, in ravine, 200 ft. deep, course N.20*W.
28.35	Ravine, 250 ft. deep, course N.30*W.
