31.00	Ridge point, 300 ft. high, descends toward the N. Descend.
38.10	Foot of mountain, 500 ft. below sec. cor. bears N.60*E. and S.60*W.
38.15	Bottom Creek, 2.00 chs. wide., slow current, sandy bottom, course S.60*W.
40.07	The point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. falls in the creek.
40.15	Over alluvial bottom.
41.50	Set a sandstone, 24x 12x6 ins., 18 ins. in the ground, for W. C. to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked W. C. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the N. face; from which, A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears S.83 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 35 lks. dist., W. C., $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 B T. A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.7 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 105 lks. dist. marked W C $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 B T.
59.40	Creek, 10 lks. wide, in ravine 10 ft. deep, course S.60*E.
62.00	Leave bottom lands, bear NE. and SW. and ascend along S. slope of mountain,
80.14	The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34. Land, level and mountains. Soil, rich black loam and gravelly, 1st. and 3rd. rate. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder and myrtle. Undergrowth, huckleberry, sallow, wine maple, salmon- berry and ferns. Mountainous and heavily timbered lands, 80.14 chs.

	Ascend S. slope, through heavy timber and dense under- growth.
2.00	Ridge point, 50 ft. above sec. cor., bears S.80*E., and N.80*W. Descend into ravine.
8.25	Foot of descent, 150 ft. below ridge, bears NW. and SE. Over bottom land.
20.00	Ravine, 100 ft. deep, course SE.
