Subdivisions of T. 25 S., R. 9 W., W. M.,

CHAINS	
3.50	Summit of divide bet. Fall Creek and Bottom Creek, 1350 ft. above Bottom Creek, bears N.30*E. and S.30*W. Descend along steep NW. slope of mountain over small ridges and ravines.
16.50	Creek, 5 lks. wide, in ravine 250 ft. deep, course N.20*W.
23.00	Ridge point, 300 ft. high, descends toward the N.
39.99	Set a hemlock post 4 ins. sq., 3 ft. long, 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 10 on the N. & S. 15 on the S. faces; from which, A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.16 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 24 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears S.17 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 18 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
46.50	Ridge point, 350 ft. above creek, descends toward the N. Descend.
59.60	Creek, 3 lks. wide, in ravine, 300 ft. deep, course N.20*W. Over small ridges and ravines along steep NW. slope of mountain.
79.98	The cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16. Land, mountainous. Soil, gravelly; 3rd. rate. Timber, fir, hemlock, maple and cedar. Undergrowth, vine maple, sallow and huckleberry. Mountainous and heavily timbered lands, 79.98 chs.
	N.0*02'W. bet. secs. 9 and 10. Descend NW. slope, over ridges and ravines into Fall Creek, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
26.75	Foot of mountain, 1000 ft. below summit of divide, bears NE. and SW.
28.10	Fall Creek, 50 lks. wide, swift current, 3 ft. deep, stony bottom, course S.50*W. Over bottom lands.
29.70	Leave bottom and ascend steep S. slope of mountain.
