

## Retracement of North Boundary of T. 26 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General except the NE bearing tree, which cannot be found.

I re-establish this cor. in its original position as the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 25 S., R. 1 W., only, as follows:

Post above described, already set, from which

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.84\*E., 27 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 1 W S 32 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.69\*W., 86 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 1 W S 31 B T.

I obliterate marks on bearing trees referring to T. 26 S. The course of this line is West and the distance is 40.20 chs.

Land mountainous.

Soil stony, 4th rate.

Timber fir; undergrowth vine maple, hazel and fir.

West on S boundary of sec. 31, T. 25 S., R. 1 W.

Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth.

Ascend E slope.

39.81 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. on rock 12 x 12 x 5 ft. marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

I re-establish this cor. in its original position as the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. on S boundary sec. 31, T. 25 S., R. 1 W., only, as follows:

Rock above described, from which

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.31 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E., 66 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 31 B T.

A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears N.20\*W., 17 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 31 B T.

I obliterate marks on former bearing tree referring to sec. 6.

The course of this line is West and the distance is 39.81 chs.
