55.25 Bluff 100 ft. high.

77.50 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course W.

80.00 Set a basalt stone 15 x 10 x 8 ins., 10 ins. in the  
ground for cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23, marked with  
3 notches on S and 2 notches on E edge, from whichA cedar, 48 ins. diam., bears N.30\*E., 16 lks. dist.,  
marked T 26 S R 1 W S 14 B T.A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears S.22\*E., 63 lks. dist.,  
marked T 26 S R 1 W S 23 B T.A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.26\*W., 36 lks. dist.,  
marked T. 26 S R 1 W S 22 B T.A hemlock, 6 ins. diam., bears N.66\*W., 68 lks.  
dist., marked T 26 S R 1 W S 15 B T.

Land mountainous.

Soil stony, 4th rate.

Timber fir and hemlock; undergrowth vine maple and hemlock.
