	A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.5*E., 8 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 B T.
42.00	Ridge point descending N. Descend NW slope.
45.90	Bluff 40 ft. high.
47.80	Bluff 30 ft. high.
51.20	Bluff 20 ft. high.
60.00	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW. Along N slope.
72.25	Bluff 20 ft. high.
80.40	The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28. Land mountainous. Soil stony, 4th rate. Timber fir and hemlock; undergrowth vine maple, rhododendron and hemlock.
	August 25, 1910.
	At the cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28. Thence I run N.0*2'W between secs. 21 and 22. Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth. Descend N slope.
5.50	Creek, 1 lk. wide, in ravine, course NW.
28.00	Bluff 25 ft. high.
30.10	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE.
40.00	A fir, 18 ins. diam., for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S 21 on W and 22 on E side, from which A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.54*E., 30 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 22 B T. A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.67*W., 6 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 21 B T. Descend along E slope.
