

Subdivisions of T. 26 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

CHAINS

C. E. Wright in sec. 10 has a house 16 x 16 ft., barn, 12 x 12 ft., 100 rods of picket fence, 2 acres of plow land, 36 fruit trees, $\frac{1}{2}$ acre garden, 10 acres seeded to timothy, 3 head of horses; estimate value of improvements, \$1200.

Geo. Collins in sec. 9 has house 12 x 20 ft., house 10 x 12 ft., $\frac{1}{2}$ acre orchard, about 50 rods fence, 15 acres cleared, 3 horses; approximate value of improvements, \$1000.

Retracements

Note:

The following retracements are made to account for discrepancies in lines of T. 26 S., R. 1 W., developed in the resurvey of E. bdy. of secs. 24, 25 and 36, T. 26 S., R. 2 W.

I commence at the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, on S. bdy. of the Tp.; thence N.0°04'W., retracing line bet. secs. 31 and 32; at 40.25 chs. the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears W., 100 lks. dist.; at 80.15 chs. fall 110 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.

N.0°04'W.; retracing the line bet. secs. 29 and 30; at 40.01 chs. the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears W., 24 lks. dist.; at 79.89 chs. fall 46 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.

N.0°04'W., retracing the line between secs. 19 and 20; at 39.89 chs. the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears E., 23 lks. dist.; at 81.83 chs. fall 43 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20.

West, retracing the line bet. secs. 18 and 19; at 39.82 chs. the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears S., 23 lks. dist.; at 64.87 chs. fall 23 lks. N. of the witness cor. to the closing cor. of secs. 18 and 19.

I return to the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, on S. bdy. of the Tp., which is a basalt stone, 5x10x8 ins., above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the
